PART - I

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. The tenderers must get themselves fully acquainted with the area and location of stock yard and godowns vis-à-vis loading/unloading points before submission of Quotations and the rates quoted by them for transportation. Once a tender is submitted, he shall be deemed to have fully acquainted himself, with the area and location vis-à-vis loading, unloading points and he shall not be entitled to any compensation arising out of any discrepancy in size and location of Stock Yard / Godown / loading /unloading points subsequently.
- 2. In case the rates are quoted in a manner other than that mentioned above, the tenders are liable to be ignored. The tenderers should not incorporate any conditions in the tenders, as conditional tenders will be summarily rejected.
- 3. Person or Persons attesting the tender shall specify their designation and authority under which they are representing the Firm. In case of partnership firms, the names of all the partners should be disclosed and the tender document shall be signed by all the partners or their duly constituted attorneys having authority to bind all the partners in all matters pertaining to the contract. An attested and notarized copy of the partnership deed should be furnished along with the tender. In the case of a limited company the names of the Directors shall be mentioned and it shall be certified that the person signing the tender is the authorized signatory and is empowered to do so on behalf of the company. A copy of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the company shall be attached to the tender. DATE: PLACE:

- (d). Each tenderer while submitting his tender, shall submit a declaration as to whether he has any relative within the meaning of Section 6 read with Schedule 1-A of the Companies Act 1956 employed in any capacity in the Corporation. In case he has any relative in any capacity in the Corporation, the full name, particulars, position held under the company must be clearly indicated. In case the tender is accepted, the tenderer shall inform the corporation if any relative as defined above joins the company at any time subsequent to the award of the contract and during continuance of the contract.
- (e) Registration No. under Provident Fund Act 1952 ESI act 1948 as amended from time to time should be mentioned.

- 14. Tenderer should have his office or his agent at any of the places like BENGALURU / HUBBALLI / BELAGAVI with telephone, mobile and Fax Facilities, so as to arrange vehicles in time on demand.
- 15. KSSIDC reserves the right to assign the Transportation work to more than one transport Agency/Contractor, as well as to entrust Transportation work at any place to any Transporter in the interest of the Consignee/Corporation at the discretion of KSSIDC. Definite volume of work cannot be guaranteed.
- 16. The successful tenderer should execute an agreement in the prescribed format on a stamped paper of appropriate value within FIFTEEN days from the date of acceptance of tender and should also furnish within FIFTEEN days a security deposit for the value as indicated above in the form of Cash/Bank Guarantee for a period of two and half years from the date of contract. The security deposit will not carry any interest.

- 17. In the event of default to execute the agreement or failure to furnish the required Security deposit, or default to carry out any of the terms and conditions of the contract or failure to carry any transport work assigned or causes inordinate delay in such works, the EMD and SD will be forfeited, provided such of the forfeiture shall not prejudice the right of the KSSIDC to take such other legal action against the transporter for the specific performance of the contract.
- 18(a) The Transporter will ensure that no material will be allowed to be stacked or kept outside the consignee godown premises. Shortage/damages, if any, caused will be fully compensated to KSSIDC by the Transporter.
 - KSSIDC is not obliged to provide the Transporter with any Accessories or equipments needed for the transportation and other items of work stated above. The Transporter should himself provide necessary medical treatment to his staff, in case of accidents on duty. The Corporation shall in no manner be liable to the Contractor or any member of his workmen/staff for injury or death caused as a result of accidents either within or outside the yard/godown premises in course of work. The contractor shall be wholly responsible for any damages and will make good all claims of compensation, claimed by his labour or staff under the workmen compensation Act. He shall also indemnify the Corporation and discharge all sums that may be awarded in respect of claims for compensation arising out of or consequent to the accident, injury or death to any staff or labour working under him pursuant to the provisions of the workmen Compensation Act (Viii of 1923 and XV of 1933) or any subsequent amendment thereof. Any expenses incurred in connection with any such claims should be borne by the Contractor and the Corporation always reserves the right to pay in the first instance, such amount of compensation as is payable under the said Act/Court order and to recover the amount so paid from the Contractor by deduction from his bills, security deposit or otherwise. The balance if any will be realized as arrears of land revenue.
- 19. The Transporter will ensure that in the process of transporting and stacking of the materials in the KSSIDC Godown no damage is caused to any of the equipment's lying in the Godown as well as the property of KSSIDC. In case of any damages caused by the Transporter, to the building or equipment, the cost of damages, as assessed by the Corporation, will be recovered from the Transporter.

- 20. In the event of any shortages and damages, noticed in the consignments, the value of such shortages and damages will be recovered from the bills of the Contractor.
- 21. KSSIDC Limited, Bengaluru, does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and is not bound to assign any reason for its decision either to accept or reject partially or fully and its decision will be final and conclusive in all matters regarding acceptance or otherwise of the tenders.
 - 22. The tenderer shall furnish the latest Income Tax returns filed with the concerned department.
 - 23. The transporter shall arrange for the proper weighment of the materials at his own cost at the loading/un-loading point and shall be responsible for any shortage noticed by the consignee with reference to the weight/counting recorded by the consignee. The weight/counting recorded by the consignee at the loading and destination delivered point shall be final and binding on the transporter and value of shortage if any beyond the allowable limit will be deducted from the transporter.
 - 24. The delivery of the material to the consignee will be on weighment / No. of Sheets / No. of Pieces basis and the material should be intact.
- 25. The Transporter should arrange for protection of the material during transportation. It would be his responsibility to procure tarpaulins for covering the material and other protective materials required, if any, while loading, transporting and un-loading.
 - 26 (a) The parties to the contract are the Transport Contractors and KSSIDC Limited, represented by the Managing Director or any other officer acting on his behalf.
 - (b) The person signing the tender or any other document forming part of the tender on behalf of any other person or a firm shall be presumed to have such authority to represent such other person or the firm as the case may be, in such matter pertaining to the contract. If, on enquiry, it is found that the person concerned has no such authority, KSSIDC Ltd., represented through the Managing Director may without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies terminate the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs and damages.
